Added value Galileo

- Additional to GPS / EGNOS
 - Additional signals openly available (OS)
 - Enhancement existing SAR system
- Compared to GPS / EGNOS
 - Civil & multi-national operation of the system
 - Security issues addressed from other end (also PRS)
 - International cooperation with non-European states
 - Global availability integrity (esp. SOL)
 - Service guarantees & liability cover (?) (esp. CS)



Setting the Stage for Galileo



Where are we now? (1)

- PPP replaced by public financing at least until operational phase starts
- GJU replaced by GSA, now restructured under Commission aegis
- ESA ≈ procurement agency EU
- Legal framework: Reg. 683/2008
 - Transition from EGNOS to Galileo
 - Public governance (incl. security concerns)

Where are we now? (2)

- GIOVE-A & -B launched 2005 / 2008
 - SSTL & Astrium / Thales, launch ESA / Starsem
- 1st launch of 4 IOV sats XI/2010
- Procurement contract 1st 14 sats signed I/2010
 - OHB System & SST, launch Arianespace
- Galileo Application Days III/2010
 - Over 900 registered participants ...
